**II. CALL TO ORDER-TOWN CLERK**

Patricia Stach, Town Clerk of DuPage Township, called the 2018 Annual Town Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. on April 10, 2018. Highlighted were the following awards given to the Township at the Annual Township of Illinois Conference:

**III. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

All those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance, led by Judy Youngs, Senior Club Member and Linda Youngs, former DuPage Township Assistant to the Supervisor.

**IV. CLERK'S WELCOME**

Town Clerk Patricia Stach welcomed everyone, and then gave a brief statement about events in DuPage Township government for the year 2017-2018.

**V. MOTION TO SET SALARY FOR MODERATOR**

**Annual Town Meeting Resolution #18-05: Yearly Audit.**

A motion was made by Maureen Fox and seconded by Tracey Odum to approve Town Meeting Resolution 18-05 Yearly Audit. A voice vote indicated all were in favor and the motion carried.

**XI. Other Business:**

Judy Bredeweg - President of the over 200 member Senior Club, thanked the Township for the renovations of the Levy basement bathroom for the Men's Club. Judy also thanked Linda Youngs, former Assistant to the Supervisor, for her service to the Township and all she has done for the Township seniors. She noted that the seniors have discussed what has happened with her position, and they have expressed some concerns.

Russ Hild – He noted that he would like to hear from the members that voted terminate Linda Youngs, and why she was left go. Carol Penning then expressed that this was a personnel issue.

Moderator Mayer stated that Attorney Kavanaugh advised that this was not an appropriate matter to be discussed at the meeting. Moderator Mayer invited those in attendance

to come to a Township meeting to express concerns, and advised that those meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesdays of the month.

Carol Penning thanked the Township for their continuing work with Operation Christmas and Community Service Council.
