**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DUPAGE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-10
ESTABLISHING ADVISORY COMMITTEES FOR DUPAGE TOWNSHIP TO
INCLUDE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SOCIAL SERVICES ADVISORY
COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, DuPage Township, Will County, State of Illinois (the "Township") is a duly organized and existing township and a unit of local government organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et. seq.*, and all laws amendatory thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and the Township Board of Trustees are committed to ensuring the effective administration of government and the responsible management of taxpayer money; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2019, the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees passed and approved Ordinance Number 19-10 establishing certain advisory committees for the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees have determined it to be in the best interests of the Township to establish an additional advisory committee for Social Services and General Assistance in order to assist with the orderly and efficient conduct of Township business, to increase transparency and accountability, and to provide advice as to certain, core Township matters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of DuPage Township, Will County, Illinois, that as follows:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals and findings are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. **Establishment of Social Services and General Assistance Committee.** Section 2 of Ordinance Number 19-10 is hereby amended to add the following subsection D, to read as follows:

D. Social Services and General Assistance Committee

The Social Services and General Assistance Committee shall provide advice to the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees regarding the Township's providing of social

services, the creation and definition of a mission statement for Township social services, and the Township's administration of General Assistance. The Social Services & General Assistance Committee's work shall include:

- (i) The initial receiving and evaluation of requests for social service-related expenditures or related requests for Township funds, and to make recommendations to the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees regarding action to be taken with respect to same;
- (ii) To evaluate existing Township policies regarding how social services are provided and funded by the Township and to make recommendations to the Supervisor and Township Board about how to improve same;
- (iii) The working with Township General Assistance staff to improve overall General Assistance operations and policies and to report to the Supervisor of General Assistance regarding same; and
- (iv) The drafting and proposal of a formal mission statement for Township social services programming.

Section 3. **Incorporation of Prior Ordinance Provisions.** Except as provided in Section 2 of this Ordinance, DuPage Township Ordinance Number 19-10 shall remain in full force and effect and all provisions therein shall apply to the procedures and practices of any newly established Township advisory committee created by the instant Ordinance.




