**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DUPAGE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-10
AND ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-15 ESTABLISHING ADVISORY COMMITTEES FOR
DUPAGE TOWNSHIP TO INCLUDE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
BUILDINGS, ASSETS, AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, DuPage Township, Will County, State of Illinois (the “Township”) is a duly organized and existing township and a unit of local government organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et. seq.*, and all laws amendatory thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and the Township Board of Trustees are committed to ensuring the effective administration of government and the responsible management of taxpayer money; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2019, the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees passed and approved Ordinance Number 19-10 establishing certain advisory committees for the Township; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2019, the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees passed and approved Ordinance Number 19-15 to establish an additional advisory committee for the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees have determined it to be in the best interests of the Township to establish an additional advisory committee for Township Buildings, Assets, and Grounds in order to assist with the orderly and efficient conduct of Township business, to increase transparency and accountability, and to provide advice as to certain, core Township matters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of DuPage Township, Will County, Illinois, that as follows:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals and findings are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. **Establishment of Buildings, Assets, and Grounds Committee.** Section 2 of Ordinance Number 19-10 is hereby amended to add the following subsection E, to read as follows:

E. Buildings, Assets, and Grounds Committee

The Buildings, Assets, and Grounds Committee shall provide advice to the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees regarding the Township's capital assets and related responsibilities. The Buildings, Assets, and Grounds Committee's work shall include:

- (i) The review, compilation, and documentation of all Township assets with their respective values;
- (ii) To evaluate existing Township capital needs and to make recommendations to the Township Board of Trustees regarding building or other capital improvements;
- (iii) To receive and evaluate recommendations from building and maintenance staff members and provide reports of same to the Township Board of Trustees;
- (iv) The review of excess or other capital assets or equipment and make recommended actions to the Township Board of Trustees with respect to same;
- (v) To evaluate and review practices for maintaining unincorporated Township roadways and make recommendations to the Township Board of Trustees about same; and
- (vi) The drafting and proposal of a formal mission statement for Township buildings, assets, and grounds management.

Section 3. Incorporation of Prior Ordinance Provisions. Except as provided in Section 2 of this Ordinance, DuPage Township Ordinance Number 19-10 (and Ordinance Number 19-15) shall remain in full force and effect and all provisions therein shall apply to the procedures and practices of any newly established Township advisory committee created by the instant Ordinance.




