They will need to find sources of funding to cover their utility costs like lighting and insurance etc. Their lighting bill in 2019 was approximately \$1800 alone.
 - The Trojans have paid close attention to pandemic regulations by the state and federal governments and were still able to provide free camps to township youth all of July with additional safety precautions in place.
