CALL TO ORDER: Meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Supervisor Marschke.

Public Forum on FY2021-2022 Township Budget

Supervisor Marschke gave an overview on the 2021-2022 budget that will be presented later at the regular Board meeting.

**Public Forum on FY2021-2022 Township Budget and Appropriation Ordinance
(Ordinance 21-19)**

Meeting was opened to the public for questions on the proposed budget. Trustee Braxton asked about the source of grants – Supervisor Marschke mentioned that we may receive federal and county grants. Rita Armstrong asked about the general assistance and the 303 home relief. Is that money for those that do not live in the township but are here in town. Supervisor Marschke explained that under our General Assistance, we have out “0” money for the last few years. We help those who are behind on the rent, utilities (gas, water, garbage and electricity), and mortgage. Rose Harris asked about opening up a food pantry in Bolingbrook. Supervisor Marschke said we are looking into that as well as getting Cares money to help pay for it. Ken Harris asked about the difference in actual and budgeted on the beginning balance on page 1. Supervisor Marschke advised that food pantry expenditures was moved to that line item.

ADJOURNMENT OF PUBLIC HEARING: A motion was made by Trustee Braxton and seconded by Trustee Ransom to adjourn this meeting. Upon roll call vote, the motion to adjourn was passed.
